

Here's a chance to enjoy shooting an as-issued metallic cartridge Vintage Military Rifle from any nation first issued between 1863 and 1950 (your gun doesn't have to have been made before 1950, but the model first issued before 1950). Maybe it's a trapdoor, M1 Garand, 303 British Enfield, 03 Springfield, Mauser, 6.5 Swede, Mosin-Nagant or any other vintage military rifle. Take it out and put it through its paces! The match is free but limited to 50 PPSA members.

This is an honor-system postal match where shooters complete a course of fire at any time during 6½-weeks from May 1st to June 15th, 2024, and mail targets to the match coordinator for scoring.

COURSE OF FIRE

Targets are a 19-inch bullseye and must be placed at 300 yards. Shooters will fire 20 rounds (5 prone, 5 sitting, 5 kneeling and 5 standing) at each of 2 targets for a total of 40 rounds.

CLASSES

There are two classes: Scoped (e.g. original or repro sniper rifles) and Iron Sight
